1.	Procedures for reporting and logging in and out understood?		
2.	Emergency procedures, assembly and evacuation locations understood?		
3.	Various safe routes to and from the worksite understood?		
4.	Escape routes from work area identified in case of emergency or fire.		
5.	Interfacing with Vale employees and other contractors on their work is understood?		
6.	Area specific hazards listed on the Contractor Work Permit are understood?		
7.	Personal protective equipment requirements for the areas understood? Head, eyes, noise, respirator (dust, chemicals, etc.), hands, feet, clothing, fall arrest, etc.		
8.	WHMIS requirements for MSDS's, labeling, handling & storing chemicals understood?		
8.	Confined space training, entry and rescue procedure requirements understood?

18.	Requirement for Excavation permit prior to doing any excavation (digging or drilling below grade, drilling into or breaking floor slabs etc.) understood?		
19.	The requirement to maintain all equipment brought on site in a safe condition is understood?		
20.	Vehicle and mobile equipment requirements as described in the Highway Traffic Act and O.S.H.A. are understood?		
21.	Vehicle emission checks are conducted on all mobile equipment prior to bringing it into the plant. Vehicles that do not meet the CO standard are not to be brought into the plant.		
22.	Requirement for pre-use check of cranes and mobile equipment understood?		
23.	Understands requirement to minimize the impact of work activities on workroom air quality?		
24.	When cutting, chipping or drilling concrete, dust must be suppressed by use of water or ventilation so that it does not contaminate the work area.		
25.	Housekeeping standards and daily cleanup requirement understood? Doors, walkways and stairs to be kept clear at all times.		
26.	Disposal methods for waste oil, process material, asbestos, steel, wood, and garbage understood?		
27.	Understands all injuries and incidents must be immediately reported to Vale contact, a follow up investigation must be conducted and an investigation report must be submitted?		
28.	Electrical Safety Authority (ESA) inspection for all site trailers.		
29.	Construction PHR completed. To be reviewed with all employees on job prior to start of job?		
30.	If plans deviate, PHR is to be updated and reviewed with employees before continuing work. All changes to be communicated with Vale Contact Person.		
31.	Contractor Work permit & Pre-Job Checklist to be reviewed with all employees prior to start of job.		
32.	All rigging is inspected prior to use and all hoisting devices have been inspected and certified?		
33.	It's understood that Vale tools and equipment are not to be used in execution of the work?		
34.	If sub-contractors are to be used they must follow Vale Standards and Policies.
